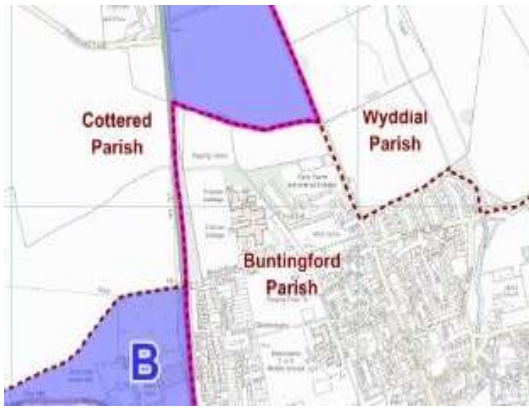
Multi-million pound funding for Stortford
