### Energy saving funding boost for businesses

Grant funding is available to help businesses, social enterprise and charities in East Herts make energy efficiency improvements and reduce their bills.

Through the Low Carbon Workspaces programme they can receive up to £5,000 to cover a third of the cost of installing such as LED lighting, double-glazing or a new boiler.

Sawbridgeworth Memorial Hall secured a grant towards fitting LED panels, pipework insulation and smart heating controls. They expect to reduce their bills by over £800/year.
