Updated release - Councillors fund local good causes

Hertfordshire County Council's locality budget scheme has funded thousands of community projects since it was launched in 2009, supporting local good causes and making a real difference to people across Hertfordshire.

County councillors work closely with local communities to identify local issues and have £10,000 a year each to spend on worthwhile projects in their area. They welcome applications from across the local community. The following grants have been made in recent weeks:

Cllr Ken Crofton (Hertford Rural) has allocated £350 to Walkern Elderberries to help towards the cost of taking elderly and disabled residents of Walkern on a boat trip.

Cllr Crofton has also allocated £500 to Ardeley Walkern Cricket Club to help towards general running costs.

Cllr Crofton has also allocated £400 to Stevenage Group Riding for the Disabled to help towards the cost of providing special equipment to assist disabled riders.

Cllr Crofton has also allocated £500 to The Living Room Hertfordshire to help towards the costs associated with people achieving long term recovery from addiction.

Cllr Crofton has also allocated £750 to Aston Parish Council to help towards the cost of the provision of 14 metal finger signs to go on existing footpath posts.
